### Editorial

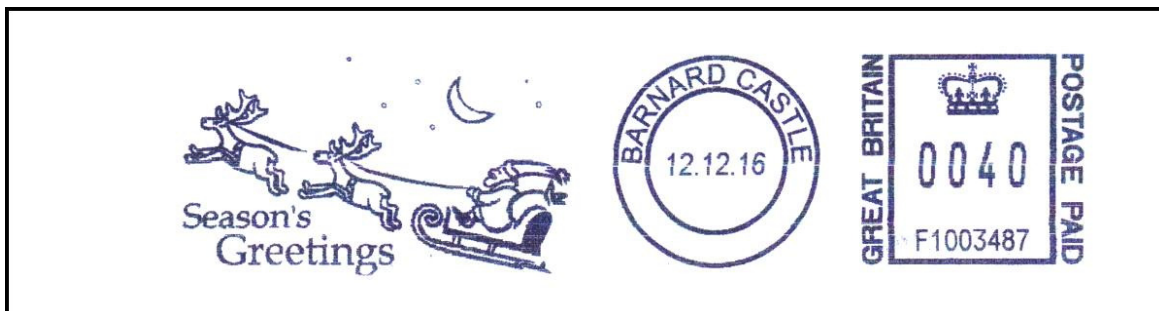
